Notice of Race

Rules: This regatta is governed by the “rules” as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

Eligibility, Entry, Entry Fee:

Eligibility requirements for boats are that they are a Naples Sabot. Eligibility requirements for competitors are that they are eleven (11) years of age or younger, and that they are a current member of INSA.

Entries must be delivered or sent to Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club by **NOON** on Tuesday, July 14, 2009. It would be helpful if each club would deliver their entries as a group along with a seeding sheet of their sailors, starting with their top sailors.

There will be a \$15.00 entry fee for this regatta.

Schedule of Events:

08:30 to 10:00 - Check In on the BCYC upper patio.

09:30 – Seeding/Coaches meeting; all participating clubs should have a representative present.

10:00 – Skipper’s Meeting on the BCYC upper patio. All sailors will receive their Flight Ribbons at this time (if needed). Ribbons must be attached to the clew of the sailors Sabot.

11:00 – First Warning Signal. Subsequent races will be started as soon as practicable after race one each day. There will be no scheduled lunch break if sailing in flights; sailors should eat either before the first start or during their ‘Bye Race’. If flights are not needed, we will take a 30 to 45 minute lunch break.

Races: If there are more than 50 sailors, each sailor will be assigned to a Flight designated by a color, and will be given a ribbon of that color to be attached to the clew of their sail. Each flight will sail four races and will have one bye race, which would be a good time to have lunch, as there will be no formal lunch break if flights are needed.

*If there are 50 competitors or less, flights will not be used and a scheduled lunch will be arranged.

Lunch: BCYC will be providing bagged lunches, please try to preorder lunches indicated on your registration form. Lunch is provided and is included in the entry fee for all competitors. There may be no scheduled lunch break if flights are needed, so sailors should eat during their bye race in this case. In the event of 50 sailors or less, we will take a lunch break of 30-45 minutes.

Parking: Parking in the BCYC lot will be open for everyone. If parking lot is full additional parking is available on the street east of the YC. Trailers will be kept in the east end of the parking lot.

Notice to Competitors: Notice to competitors will be posted on the BCYC Official Notice Board located on the upper patio from the flagpole.

Sailing Instructions: Available at registration.

Weights: Skipper weights are not required for a Sabot II Qualifier or Championship event. However, the Race Committee maintains the right to request a sabot measurement certificate (i.e. 2009 INSA sticker) to confirm a hull's weight and measurements meet the required standards of INSA.

Racing Area: Will be located in the Turning Basin of Balboa Bay

Scoring: Low point-scoring system per Appendix A. However Appendix A is modified as follows: Each boat's score shall be the total of her race scores. (There will be no “throw-outs”).

Arbitration: All protests involving Racing Rules of Part 2 will first be submitted to arbitration. The arbitration procedure will be posted on the Official Regatta Notice Board as an addendum to the Sailing Instructions.

Awards: Awards will be presented after last race.
