



NOTICE TO BUILDERS

The INSA Board is re-evaluating the measurement process and certification of builders to ensure one design compliancy across the class. This will protect our members so that all sailors will be sailing in and against Naples Sabots that have passed inspection.

Further, the Measurement team will determine the following:

- a) Re-certification of all molds
- b) Determine at what point a boat needs to be re-measured
- c) Re-certification of all measurers

Currently the recognized active builder is:
Bedford Boats

Any hull leaving a builder must be a class legal hull. A bare hull may be delivered. Bare hull consists of completed hull with side rails and thwarts in place. Once a boat is rigged, the hull will then be officially measured and weighed per Class rules.

Builders wishing to revive an older mold must first build a boat that passes measurement. Once the boat has passed, the builder will be certified and hull numbers issued.

Hull numbers will only be issued in advance to INSA certified builders.
